GEORGIA

SANDRA
Okay we should get a move on

Sandra pauses, and almost chuckles to herself.

SANDRA (CONT'D)
I Hate being late.

Sandra links arms with Georgia and leads her into the night.

As they leave another older woman (MIRANDA) with short hair
and a bohemian wardrobe can be seen looking around the
station. She gets out her phone and makes a call.

INT. GIN PALACE - EVENING

A Packed Gin Palace is bustling and lively. The space is clean, well lit and the quiet sound of a live pianist brings an air of elegance.

At a table in the centre of the restraint Sandra and Georgia sit silently. Sandra is staring across at Georgia who idly stirs the cocktail stick in the dry martini in front of her.

Georgia looks up and meets Sandra's gaze.

SANDRA

So... what is it do you think that attracts people to you?

Georgia thinks for a second.

GEORGIA

I don't know... Why did you want to take me out.

Sandra takes a sip of her drink, pauses then takes another longer sip.

SANDRA

I... I guess I just wanted to get to know you... you interested me

GEORGIA

But why?

SANDRA

I guess you seemed like someone I could explore... this with

GEORGIA

This?

SANDRA

You know

Sandra lowers her voice to a whisper

SANDRA (CONT'D)

Courting women

Georgia in the middle of taking a sip, stops and puts the drink down.

GEORGIA

On the app you said you had been out for a long time.

SANDRA

Yes... of course

Sandra takes another long sip and finishes her drink.

SANDRA (CONT'D)
I mean... younger women.

Georgia finishes her drink and stands up.

SANDRA (CONT'D)
Is everything alright

GEORGIA
I don't know who you are but you're
clearly not Miranda.

Georgia walks out. Sandra gets up to follow but is stopped by
a well dressed SERVER.

SERVER
I'm sorry Ma'am, but you need to
settle your bill first.

SANDRA
Oh yes.

Sandra hurriedly pulls out some cash and puts it on the table
and follows after Georgia.

As she leaves the server picks up the money and is shocked by
how much Sandra overpaid by.

EXT. GIN PALACE - EVENING

Georgia is walking away the lights of the Gin palace getting
farther away as she listens to her phone ringing, waiting for
someone to answer.

Eventually somebody does.

GEORGIA
Miranda, Hi... Listen I am sooooo
sorry about tonight I...

She's cut off by the muffled sound of an angry voice on the
other end of the line.

GEORGIA (CONT'D)
Yes I know, I just want to explain

She's Cut off again

GEORGIA (CONT'D)
Yes I know and I'm sorry, Cant we
reschedule...

There's a calm pause before the line goes dead. As it does
Sandra hurries her way to Georgia.

SANDRA
Georgia wait I just want to

Georgia turns angrily

GEORGIA

Want to what! I'm sure in your head
you have a perfectly good reason
for ruining my business!

SANDRA

I...

GEORGIA

And I would love to hear more all
about how you know about me in the
first place.

SANDRA

I didn't mean to...

GEORGIA

Yes I'm sure you didn't mean to,
but you did, so tell me what gives
you the right to Lie to me and
destroy my reputation!

Sandra responds to the aggression with aggression.

SANDRA

What gives you the right to sleep
with my husband!

Georgia stops. She lets the anger fade away in a deep breath.
She begins walking. Sandra follows

GEORGIA

I as a rule, don't sleep with my
clients.

Sandra Scoffs

SANDRA

A prostitute that doesn't have sex.
I'm not that gullible

Georgia looks at her sideways

GEORGIA
